

Public Rights of Way Works on the Network – 7 December 2022 to 6 June 2023

1. Signposting - 25 path signposts erected across Ainsworth, Radcliffe, Ramsbottom, Bury and Prestwich.



1. Bridleways 5 and 17, Ramsbottom and Footpath 3, Ramsbottom MOD – The Authority funded and the MOD organised works to three public rights of way on Moorbottom Road that cross land under the management of the Holcombe Training Centre. These are considerable drainage and re-instatment works that allow the Moorbottom Road bridleway to be ridden without the need to dismount and will protect the paths during heavy rainfall.



2. Bridleway 41, Bradshaw Hill, Bury
Rebuild horse stile. Repair surfacing. Cut back vegetation and clear drainage.



3. Footpath 28, Dovehouse Close, Whitefield
Clear debris from steps

4. Footpath 148, Jackson Close, Bury
Provide a level, crushed stone surface to a path offering access on foot to schools in the Elton area. Funded as part of a project to reduce the use of vehicles around Guardian Angels Primary School.

5. Footpath 57, Manor Street, Ramsbottom
Introduced steps to create an easier to use access to the footpath.
6. Footpaths 17 and 19 Christchurch, Radcliffe
Replaced 7 stiles on land forming part of Dearden Fold Farm with 6 kissing gates and 1 pedestrian gate. Drainage cleared. Working with the agreement of the landowner.
7. Bridleway 27a, Bridle Road and Old Hall Lane, Simister, Prestwich
Substantial vegetation clearance and creation of a crushed stone surface to improve access along 1.8km of highways on both sides of the M60 and the footbridge across the motorway at the boundary of Heaton Park. Installation of a new barrier on Bridle Road to prevent vehicular access

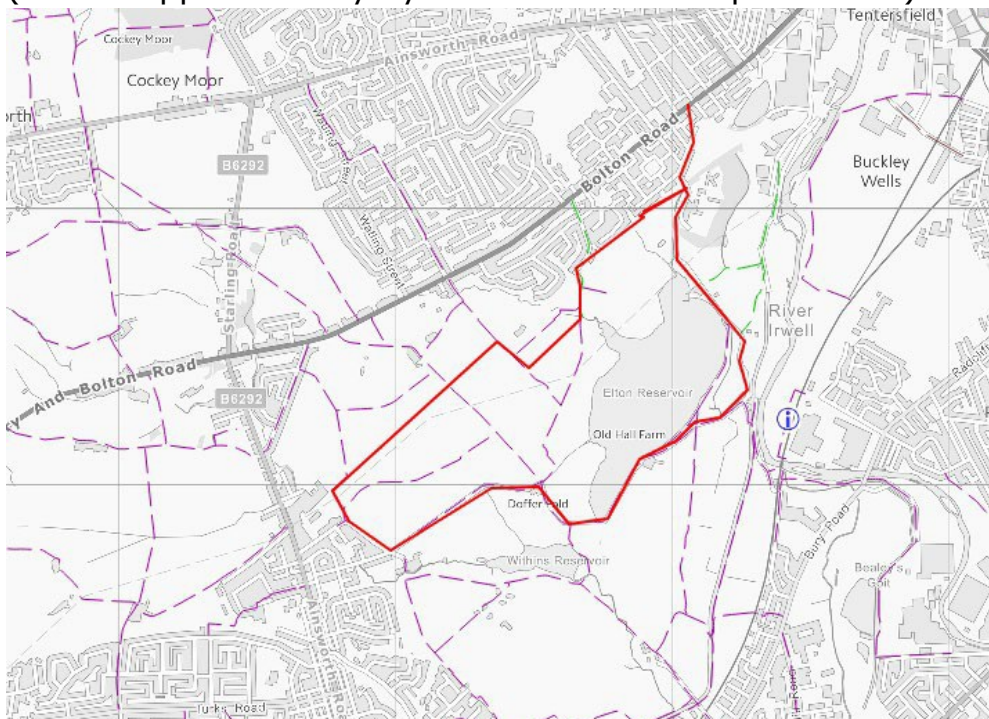


8. Footpath 19, Redisher Woods, Ramsbottom.
Installation of a footbridge across a stream and clearance of existing steps. This completes a project of installing three sections of steps and the bridge on a steep footpath, with the assistance of The Friends of Redisher Woods, The Ramblers and The Long Distance Walkers Association.



9. Footpath 81, Nuttall Park, Ramsbottom
Vegetation and drainage clearance.
10. Footpath 81, Churchfields, Ramsbottom
Re-establish drainage, cut back overhanging branches and relay concrete flags.
11. Footpath Junction of 105 and 107, Ramsbottom
Repair step stile.

12. Bridleway 15, Bury
Attempt to clear the build up of debris and slurry on the bridleway surface as it passes under M66.
13. Footpath 37, Ramsbottom
Rebuilding of a concrete drainage channel.
14. Footpath 102, Shipperbottom Road, Ramsbottom
Re-instatement of drainage cover and channel.
15. Footpath 55, Sherwood Close, Tottington
Repair of drainage and potholes.
16. Upgrade to Bridleway of parts of Footpath Nos. 10 & 12 St Andrews, Radcliffe and Footpath No. 112, Bury and Addition of a Bridleway
We have received confirmation of the order to create a bridleway from St Andrews Road, Radcliffe, along the south east boundary of Elton Reservoir through to Buller Street, Bury.
17. Bridleway Creation at Spen Moor, Radcliffe
The Authority has made two creation orders for a bridleway linking Hardman Street, Radcliffe through to Buckingham Drive, Bury. There were no objections to the orders.
Items 16 and 17 will create a circular route for off road walking and riding between Bury and Radcliffe at Spen Moor and Elton Reservoir (Shown approximately by the red line of the plan below)



18. Footpath 7, Unsworth Academy, Whitefield

Footpath diverted to allow development to take place at the Academy, creating a route that removes security issues and creates and extended path through greenspace.
